At the regular meeting held today all members and their attorney were present.

Mr. W. E. Bowman, 10A-E Custis Ave., Alex., Va came to ask that something be done about the road into his sub-div in the 8th Elec. Dist. which adjoins Far Cry Farm, T A McInerny's property. Mr. Bowman asks that 2 mi of road be built deed was granted for Right of Way in 1950 by T A McInerny, to So Md. Elec Co-Op. no other R of W deed on record. Letter has been addressed to him asking if any other deed was ever given-if so it is not recorded. Mr. Bowman said roadwork was promised in 1950

Melvin Weeks and wife, came in about Capt Pearly Weeks- the latter was found wanderings along the road, and brought to jail to determine his sanity-seemed in a daze- examined by doctor Boyd who said he was not harmful-later before a second examination was held 2 daughters came to ask that Capt Weeks be released in their custody as they did not want him sent away now-agreement was prepared and they signed same, whereby County officials are relieved of any responsibility in the matter, Mrs. Violet and Mrs. Lillie Neill-he will remain at the Neill home

Miss Dent and Atty R E Wigginton came in about ditch drainage etc. on school property in Ex.Pk. This is not a County problem

Miss Dent presented request for \$90,000 for teachers increment for 56-7 read scale of salaries for Md schools and St Mary's County is lowest. It is almost impossible to secure teachers when other counties bid for their services at higher salaries. Mr. Guy suggested that within the past 5 years St Mary's County teachers had been raised \$700 -feels the Gen Assembly should pass law setting salaries for teachers in each grade. Miss Dent pointed out that many janitors receive more than some teachers.

Mr. J Ralph Abell requested permission to have Virginia Burroughs prepare the Notices for Tax Review set for Dec 15-to be done on her own time this was granted.
