Mr. Ernest Bell who wants to lease Alms House farm, will consider leasing the house as well after he has a chance to inspect same. He will report later.

Mary Agnes Buckler with Shrf. Miedzinski and St. Trooper Burlison came in about an increase in her salary-she is paid \$300 per yr as Committing magisträte and is available at all times for this work- police rely on her altogether to accept the collateral on traffic violations etc. Board will consider the matter.

Ford James-St. Geo. Creek- old John Davis property says road into his place is in very bad condition. Road goes next to Webster Poe's property and passes Geo. E. Thomas' store. County will view road to determine if is County or private road.

Mr. Giddings of Andover wants road into his farm repaired. County will have to view same to determine if it is County or private road.

Mrs. Albert Wood, Oakville who had requested remuneration for carrying children to and from school bus stop and to school was allowed \$1.00 per day for remainigg school days- 18 in Mar-Spril and May, 15 in June, making a total of \$69.00 She was advised of this by letter.

Letter from Supervisor of Election, clerk and member asking that Voting machines be purchased from the Shoup Voting Machine Corp. Sts. Sen. Jos A Mattingly asks for interview with Board before they purchase any machines.

Board adjourned at 3 pm.
