Present this morning were the three Commissioners, their attorney and members of the Court House Building Committee. The base bid of M.M. Dean, General Contractor of Hollywood, Md., was accepted, with alternates #1-3- and 9. This totals \$338,285.00. Mr. Tilp, architect, notified Mr. Dean and a letter was also written advising Mr. Dean of the bid acceptance. Mr. Dean was asked to hold the price of alternates #3-6-7-8-10 alternates 4-5-11-and 12 are out.

Mr. Thos Waxter, Director of State Dept of Welfare was present, at a closed session. The County Director was discussed, her methods etc. The consensus of opinion was that there is unrest on the part of members of the County Welfare Bd concerning Mrs. Rapp, they feel she is not efficiently administering the responsibility of her office; that she does not get on very well with all members of her staff. Mr. Waxter will consult with his State Staff and advise the Commissioners of their decision.

Clerk was asked to call Mr. Thompson's attention to the road at Camp Dengee.

The Board adjourned at 2 pm after conferring with Mr. Meredith of Welfare, on list of names who are among those suing the Bd of Education for integration -the list was examined to ascertain whether any of the people thereon were receiving County aid and none were found.
