All members of the Board and their attorney were present at today's regular session.

Mrs. Wiegman of Piney Pt. phoned regarding conditions at her property- Mr. Alvey advised her that it was a matter for the Health Dept.

Herman Hewett offered \$50 each for property of Flotie Morgan Barnes and Noah Morgan, 1st Elec. Dist bought at Tax Sale in 1932. It was ascertained that Flotie Barnes place was 10 acres of woodland, that Noah Morgan's is 17 acres of woodland. Mr. Sterling will investigate and determine whether it is a good stand of timber, or just woodland growth. Decision will be made at next meeting.

Mr. Charles Knott, manager of Sotterly, was in about sheep killed by dogs belonging to Gerald Fenwick and others in that neighborhood. Several of the dogs were killed. Mr. Knott will contact owners of the other dogs and send in his claim later. He advised that lambs were worth 26¢ per lb.

Sheriff Miedzinski brought in a check from the So. Md. Warehouse for tobacco which it was claimed was dropped from a truck and picked up by parties not the owners. Check was made to the sheriff and he endorsed it to the County Commissioners.

Clerk was requested to write County Commissioners in Charles and Calvert County to ascertain whether they would be interested in a Tri-County owned and managed Dog Pound, to be located near Hughesville. If they are interested, a meeting of the officials of the 3 counties will be arranged for later.

County accepted DEED for the Nalley-Davis-Wallace road in the 6th elec, dist ✓ Liber CBG 62 folio 433. SRC was notified of this, as was Mr. Thompson.

McKay's Beach-group of taxpayers there request something be done about the beach road. Several desire the present 14 ft road to be gravelled, improved and surface treated-others desire that a survey be made to establish road lines- Mr. Briscoe who represented several of the parties said the roadbed should be resurveyed as there is a question as to whether or not it is properly located. No decision reached by the Board. Present were Messrs. Bobagello-2 Damerons-Coffey-Knorr Long, McKay, Koegel, Drank, and McWhorter.
