All members and their attorney were present at today's meeting.

Dr. Houser came in to report on his meeting with FHA officials on Thursday- advises one realtor is not making proper reports etc. This is out of the hands of the County Commissioners.

Clerk was asked to phone Dr. Houser to accompany the Commissioners on Friday next to LaPlata about the Tri-County dog pound also about a tri-county nursing home. This was done.

Commissioners asked Mr. Sterling to prepare a lease for Fair Grounds for 25 years, at \$100 per year-they can release the organization from paying rent whenever they desire.

Commissioners decided to go on EST as of midnight Sunday Sept 30- both papers, Miss Dent, banks etc., were notified by phone of this change. Legal ads will appear this week only. Navy not considered as they are to go on Oct 31- If time is changed Sunday midnight this will not interfere with the time of services in any churches in the County as they can be notified at Sunday services.

Advise Dr Houser the reason the Sam Perkins case cannot be rushed thru is that both Mr and Mrs Perkins have a small bank account, he has a life insurance and she has a small legacy and they are not willing to divulge the amounts on hand. Until they do, nothing can be done about getting him to Deers Head where he will only have to remain about 3 months then he can walk again.

Zoning Case heard- then advertised for hearing on Tues Sept 26- at 2:30 pm to "Rezone from "A Residential" to "C Commercial" between Frankling Roosevelt Rd and Navy R of W on south side of 3 Notch road, 400 ft in Lex Pk- Zantzinger, Hutcherson, Kane, Tapp et al property. No protests. Rezoning oks as requested.
