Special Meeting

At the special meeting which was held today Commissioners Alvey and Stone, and their attorney Wm. Sterling were present.

Delegation from Hermanville, appeared regarding the Robert Stevens road. They presented a petition signed by the taxpayers along the road, and asked that something be done to fix it for winter use, and later to repair the road properly. Mr. Alvey contacted Mr. Thompson about this and he will see what can be done.

Dr. Houser and Dr. Locke came in regarding sewage conditions at the Hohensee Trailer Camp and Mr. J.H. Spencer's on the G Mills road. Both places are health menaces. Both men promise to do what they can to go along with the Health regulations. If not, warrants will be issued for both

Benedict Smith-with subdivision in 1st Dist. wants road repaired at Cardinal Gibbon's institute- will furnish gravel for the work and will have DEED for R of W recorded.

Representative of the State Tax Commission, Mr. Ciro, asst. to Mr. Mueller will cover the western shore area in the new tax work.

Mr. Jack Reeder, chief inspector for Pr. Geo. County was in about the sewage conditions at Spencer's. He had a long conference with Mr. Sterling.

Mr. Feldman of Patuxent Beach came in about 7 Gables Road- there appears to be trouble in securing the signature of 2 taxpayers on this road, so road will be built up to their property, but not on it.

Tall Timbers- repairs on seawall necessary- Mr. Thompson will see about advertising for bids on this work

Hood's Trailer Camp- Dr Locke feels that right now the sewage disposal at this camp is ok, but in the very near future it will not be adequate and will be a major problem. Mr. Hood agreed to build a septic tank as per existing laws.
