When asked why the amount for Civil Defense was increased to Mr. Thompson explained that much more money would be required to purchase equipment etc., this year 1957-58 than heretofore.

Harry Lancaster came in about mileage to California to pick up Harry Mattingly Navy considers it is 3,000 miles each way.

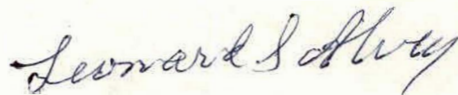
Wire from State Roads Commission asking for decision on amount of State Roads Bonds Board desires, prior to December 1, 1956

Board agreed to execute Agreement and Grant of Permission from the SRC to County Commissioners for the purpose of permitting St Mary's County Fair Association to erect and maintain a fence on SRC R of W at Alms House property, and to use land of SRC R of W until such time as the R of W will be needed for roadway use.
