The County Commissioners and their attorney met today in regular session.

Water coolers installed in basement and on 2nd floor, Smith's Inc \$200.00 each
Board will decide later if needed.

Rads- Ed Whalen of Charlotte Hall came in again about his road

Smith-Schmalgemeyer Road, 6th Elec. Dist will get 30 ft R of W, road to be
accepted for maintenance.

Gasparovic Road- goes round Little Snow Hill, secure R of W at upper end of this
road

Town Creek- Col. Henderson asks for Civic Association, that curves be eliminated
this cannot be done as road is already built to SRC specifications
Asks for sign 40 MPH limit on Route 235

Board will ask SRC for survey to determine miles per hour for that route.

Hermanville Road, check to see if possible to secure Fed aid for this road, Mr.
Webb will see Mr. Duncan about this -Needs survey and cross sections. If ed funds
not available, will go ahead and surface road but cannot widen it.
Mr. Winters says that since last October he has been trying to get an entrance to his
property, has already put in 2, there was a ditch and long turn when Melvin Jarboe
graded along the ditch. Mr. Thompson promised to put in a 16 inch pipe, but the
gravel has piled up so high you can hardly get in and out after a heavy rain.
Reeder and Hayden agreed the road should be cleaned, but SRC should clean it.

Mr. Oliver Baldwin of Charlotte Hall presented bid for Dump sites, Told to go
ahead and prepare ditch at all 4 pits, and cover up the full ones. He wants a
contract for this. WOE Sterling will prepare the contract. Town Creek area.

JJ Finnacom, Tall Timbers, road was accepted last winter. Cannot do anything until
after July 1st, SRC cannot do any work on County roads until after July-will maintain
the road.

Mr. Hines asked for Mosquito Control at St. Mary's each, A prox. cost \$500, based
on June 56 estimate will need 4 sprayings \$125 each \$125.00 SM County, \$125. SM each
bal from State. Clerk to write and ask Dr. Langford if this price still holds
Not allowed in Budget for this year. Advise Mr. Hines of this.

Write to Montana Snack Bar and Mac & Grace, advising tins along road, also garbage
and trash also advise the Sea Breeze Club, to use dump instead of roadside.

Ask about land from Mrs Frank Copage towards Drayden, for dump site.

Mr. Miller and Board considered the Fire Tax vote to be held Aug 20, setting up

voting machines etc. If voted for, tax to be added on 1958 bills which will be prepared in January 1958 but not sent out until June. Commissioners feel this extra vote could have been held when Primaries are held, rather than go to this extra expense.

Referring to bus transportation of pupils to Ryken High School, Paul Bell to contact Alex Hebb and ascertain time the 2 busses would meet at 7 Gables Road.

James Bradley has land which he may sell for dump site. Mr. Hartwell will check this.
