All officials present at today's meeting.

Dr. Houser came in to talk about the sewage disposal system- lots frequently too small for proper drainage for dwellings to be built on them. Feels Commissioners should have law requiring percolation test before any lot is sold also law against selling lots for home sites when they are too small for proper drainage. He wants Plumbing Fee cancelled and Bldg Permit cost increased- wants Ordinance enacted that no building can be constructed until after percolation tests is satisfactory. Also would like one sanitarian to make all percolation tests.

County now pays 29% of the total costs of Health Office, State pays 71% If sanitarians take college course in bacteriology and sanitation, State will assume their salaries-until this is done County must pay them

Mrs. Florence Drury reports that colored parochial school bus stops near rail road tracks and Groves near California and small girl gets out wand waves traffic from right then left side, stops cars -until child comes to get on bus-ties traffic up 5- 10 minutes. Isaac Gant is driver of this bus and he has been advised to draw bus to shoulder of road and not interfere with traffic when he waiting this long.

Sheriff wants Identoscope for office, get photos and fingerprints for file and FBI for future use. Suggests equipment be bought from State refurnishing an office. Clerk requested contact Gen. Munshower about this.

Mr. Carr of SRC sent in specifications for sea wall at Tall Timbers.

Dumping still continues on Willow Road tho signs are up forbidding this.

Ask Mr. Bond about use of County funds to pay for cleaning of dumps etc and County to use SRC equipment.

Mr. Tile requested to draw up plans for addition to Welfare and to contact Mrs Meredith about same. ~~Also to draw up plans for Nursing Home/~~

Wed at noon, 3 Comms, Mr. Sterling and legislators to meet with the SRC and Mr. Bond.
