The three County Commissioners with their attorney were in session today.

Bd. of Education, Mr. King and Mrs. Hayden came in about permission to change the Budget for 58-59 to use the money allocated to Ridge School to some other schools. The Commissioners agreed to this and change was made in their (Bd. of Ed ca) budget accordingly. Photostat machine has been purchased by the Bd. Educa offered its use to the Commissioners at any time- takes paper 8 x 11 1/2" Mr. King asked decision as to teachers' salaries, was advised that after a conference with the auditors, the Commissioners will give him an answer next Wed. Town Creek School is Federal grant Salary of teachers-it is hoped will be equal to those in Charles and Calvert counties, if possible. 200 teachers with \$300 increase, \$60,000.

State Roads Commission, Commissioners asked Mr. Bond if he could begin work at Town Creek, telephone call to Mr. Duncan elicited information that he was waiting approval of State Roads Comm in Baltimore before telling Mr. Bond to go ahead with Town Creek which was put in place of Laurel Grove since R/W there could not be obtained. Mr. Bond feels amount allocated to Laurel Grove will almost do the work at Town Creek \$10,365-will probably build 1 mi or a little over as there is little grading and cleaning necessary.

Mr. Lloyd Johnston of the 4th phoned to know the status of the R/W thru Dr J. Bay Jacobs land- no reply from Dr. Jacobs as yet. Will write another letter 4/16
