All three Commissioners, with Attorney Sterling, met today.

Mosquito Control

Dr. Foster, Md. Univ. with Mr. Johnson, came in about the Mosquito Control work for this year. After a lengthy talk on the subject the Commissioners decided to allocate the sum of \$1500.00 to the State and the allocation of various sums for the several areas which have applied for the control should be decided by the State. During the meeting 2 additional requests were made by phone

Mr. Brickley stated Mr. Johnson advised him if he put up \$100 for work in that area the Commissioners would match it and the State double that. Mr. Brickley was advised to contact Dr. Foster for this work. Any further expenses, after the \$1500 has been used, must be paid for in full by the area requesting the work.

Mr. Cook came in during the meeting and asked if Hollywood Shores could be helped if they put up the full 50% would the State match it. Dr. Foster replied the State would do so, but the group of citizens in Hollywood would have to send their money to the Commissioners, since the Commissioners would be required to sponsor the project.

Budget for 1959-60 should carry appropriation for Mosquito Control. Heretofore funds needed have been taken from the Cushion fund.

J.D. Bond and Mr. Cryer came to discuss the matter of Mrs. McCully blocking up the pipe which drains Mr. Cryer's place. It was finally determined that Mr. Alvey would go with Mr. Bond and look this over, because it is a matter between Mr. Cryer and Mrs. McCully.-not for the County or State.

Mr. Guy requested that a letter be written to Mr. Cato Merchant, Tex. Park, asking that he visit the County Commissioners any regular meeting day and discuss the matter which seems to give Mr. Merchant the wrong impression of the Commissioners

Gen T A McInerney, Park Hall- complains about bad road. Mr. Bond was notified

Board of Education- Mr. Robert King, Supt and Mrs Elberta Hayden came in to discuss the Teachers' increment for 1958-9 Mr. Alvey informed the only way he could see it, was to pay them a lump sum at the close of the school year-June 59. Mr. King advised that the Bd. of Education has received more funds from the Fed. Govt than anticipated, and they could use their surplus to pay that increment in 59 if the Commissioners can take care of it in the future. Mr. Alvey said he was sure it could be done and a letter was then written to Mr. Edward Thomas, Pres. Bd. of Education asking his approval. The school Budget for 58-59 was presented to the Commissioners for signature of all 3. They had used the basis sent in by the State Tax Commission, and not the one submitted by County Auditors and Clerk.

Mr. King then explained that they have on hand an unused portion of funds which had been allocated to certain schools, but said schools did not require the full amount. He asked permission to use this money for schools which required more than was allocated and the Commissioners signed a letter to this effect. The Commissioners have been advised by the Comptroller that all State School Loans obtained after Jan 1, 1958 will not have to be budgeted by the Commissioners, but when interest and principal is due the State will withhold the necessary amounts from funds due them from State sources. The last loan- deposited \$200,000 will be paid for this way. The Commissioners and Mr. King both felt that the meeting was a very satisfactory one

Referring to the matter of the septic tank et al., for Nicolet Park- Mrs. Nicolet has contacted Dr. Locke and he will advise her if the present sewage system can be used, if not he will make necessary arrangements for installation of the tanks.
