

August 26, 1958

Regular session held today with all members and their attorney present.

Board advised Shrf. Miedzinski appointment of 5th Deputy was approved to become effective December 1958, which is time sheriff takes office.

Lexington Park Rescue Squad came in to request assistance for this year. They were advised the Budget is set up for them for \$700 for 1958-59 and check was handed them for that amount. Ridge Ambulance Rescue Squad is also included in the Budget for \$700

Fire Marshal advises there should be Fire Extinguishers in the Health Bldg Mr. Tilp will advise the Board where to place these articles in the Court House.

Wm. F. Herbert, Tax Assessor came in to ask that multi-purpose machine be purchased for work in Tax Assessor's office. Machine cost \$700, approximately - Board will consider request and advise him later.

Bus Extension- Paul Bell's Bus goes to Aubrey Stone's and stops on main road where he will pick up Merton Denly's child and take him to Little Flower- cannot make the trip to St. John's- Mr. Denly was so advised by letter

Geo. Huntt granted extension of route, will advise exact bus mileage after school opens.

Group residing on California-Post Office road ask when road is to be repaired advises that holes in road are 10 and 12 inches deep Mr. Bond informed them the weather last winter was so hard on roads he is still repairing them 14 families reside on this road and school bus uses it- Messrs. Loftus, Lynch, Evans, Ambruster, Gunther and others were in the group Mr. Bond informed them that the road will be widened and ditched-in 1958- road will be graded, gravelled and black topped early in Sept as the Rolfe Black Top Supply Company closes down then. This will be done after Town Creek road is black topped.

McInerney Road- property owners advised SRC must have 40ft R/W altho 7 years ago SRC accepted 30 ft R/W, part of the road has been built .4 mi Mr. Bond will contact property owners for the additional 10 ft R/W and report later to the Commissioners. Mr. Smith and Mr. McDnald came in about this road.

Board adjourned at 3 pm to go to Tall Timbers and meet with Mr. Stephen Foxwell about seawall repairs.
