

Tuesday November 12, 1958

November 4 and 11 being holidays, no meetings were held.

Today the Commissioners and their attorney met in regular session.

Mrs. Clem Cheseldine requested transportation to SMA for 1 child- no extra mileage was involved- request was granted.

Board asked for bids on painting at Health Dept from

Francis Weiland.

Phil Davis had previously bid on all except 1 reception room, he was asked to include this room with his first bid. Other bids were to be for all exterior woodwork and reception room. Only two bids were received-and Commissioners decided to wait another week for the other bids.

Dr. Houser and Mr. Cook came in about patients receiving Welfare, certified not able to work. If patient is certified by physician that he is unable to work he can receive Welfare. Mr. Guy felt it would be well to have 2 physicians certify to this, and then put patient clinic service can be used for such patients, on 2 certifications.

Frank Combs came in about inspection and insurance of boiler- \$50,000.00 for 3 years would cost \$245. Boilers and air conditioning system to be inspected and report made, and Mr. Combs will bring in figures for insurance later.

Mrs. Claude Gass and others came to request the Commissioners to pay Dr. Barbarich \$150.00 for apendectomy of Christine Faunce. They were advised there are no funds available for this from the Commissioners.

Roads. Bridge at St. Andrews Church Rd discussed. Town Creek Rd, men working there now, by end of week all black toping will be completed. Notley Hall Hill Rd to L. Douglas Goode's entrance, to be graded and gravelled, for maintenance only. This road should be widened as far as the light poles are located. Beitzell Rd to Jake Downs Mr. Bond will check this road. Geo. Mattingly's road was graded, is to have pipe put in and gravelled.

Roads to be built in 1959 with Federal Aid, where possible at Hermanville-Park Hall; short extension of St. Andrews Ch road; Town Creek and Snow Hill roads. Regular funds, Queen Tree, Scotch Neck- St. Jerome's Creek-L prong Andover road; Bauer road; McInerney Road; Vista road; St. Geo. Island; Frog Marsh Length and cost of these roads to be secured from Mr. Bond.
