Mr. Tilp had been advised of several items which need correction before Court House can be accepted- he will contact Mr. Dean and if Mr. Dean is not going to complete the job, Mr. Tilp will have it done and take it from the \$1,000 County owes Mr. Dean.

Langley Rd-8th Dist needs gravel on hill. SRC has accepted this road for maintenance.
