

February 17, 1959

All commissioners were present at the regular meeting held today.

1. Messrs Raley, Chapman and Weiner, representing Chamber of Commerce of Lexington Park, in regards to street and signs and lights and other improvements in the Lexington Park area. General discussion held, and matters will be further investigated by Commissioners and Chamber will incorporate all requests in a letter to be sent
2. Executive session with R.B. Broun, Jr., President of the 1st Nat Bank of St. Mary's, regarding emergency loan.
3. Mr. B. Kenedy Abell, representing St. Mary's Co. Fire Board presented a proposal of the Fire Board authorizing and directing a permanent set-up of a Central Communications facility for the County, to be enacted by the General Assembly. Matter to be discussed with the members of the Legislature
4. Wm. George came in asking if County had objection to putting up fence on a ball field at Nicotlet park, and have advertisements thereon. Mr. Hodges will look into this
5. Mr. Bond and above group from Lexington Park Chamber of Commerce met with Commissioners and discussed roads and traffic controls in Lexington Park area
6. Mr. Bricoe and Mr. Bond and Commissioners discussed the Chas. Wood's entrance problem on R 5, below St Mary's City. Take matter up with the SRC
7. Messrs. John Lancaster and Henry Ocker came to discuss future plans of United Givers Fund, to raise funds. Plans to raise funds by monthly Bingo games offering cash prizes. Cards would be sold in advance to patrons. Do not have to be present to win-cards would be sold at various public places monthly. Distribution responsibility would be of the various fire departments which would be compensated. Would be operated within the applicable law pertaining to bingo in the County. Want Commissioners idea whether such plans are adverse to the public interests. Commissioners advised group such was not against the public interest.
8. Commissioner Hodges reported that road leading thru Bayne's subdivision has not been built to County specifications.
9. Commissioner Hodges made inspection of lighting requirements in Town Creek. More complete details will be discussed later.
10. Commissioner Hodges discussed Dumpsite in 2nd Dist. Get DEED from School Board for old school site on Valley Lee road for this dump site.
11. Commissioner Hodges reported Moore at St Geo Island willing for public wharf to pass in front of his land on St Geo Isl creek to basin dug by Government.
