The Commissioners and their attorney were present at today's regular meeting.

Dr. John Foster, Univ. of Md. Mosquito Control Div., came in for a short conference it was determined by the Auditor that check in the amount of \$ 3754.80 check #6391 dated April 7, CGF #1 MOSQUITO CONTROL ACCOUNT.

St. Geo. Island permanent control was approved by the Commissioners- \$250 from St. Geo. Isl. Association \$250 from the County and \$1500 from the State. Letter to this effect was sent to Dr. Foster. Mr. Heath who accompanied Dr. Foster suggested that the Civic associations of Piney Pt. Tall Timbers, St. Geo Isl Valley Lee raise money to buy equipment, then rent it to other areas in this County. This would be used to bury trash

Seawall at St. Geo Isl. built by the County and accepted by the State- needs repairs Mr. Dempster thinks the County can get sufficient timber to take care of the repairs.

J.E. Taylor, Tall Timbers, came in about Superintendent of the Dog Pound, if and when it is in operation- read about it in a county paper. No decision.

Commissioners requested Clerk to ascertain who wrote the article on the County jail which appeared in the State report- H. Buckler said it was written by a new inspector who also inspected the jail last year.

Tall Timbers taxes for Erosion Relief Project should be kept in separate account- have Mr. Lipski do this when he comes Bank account closed 8-5-54

Arrangements have been made by Mr. Tilp to be host to the county commissioners and their attorney from Charles, Calvert and St. Mary's Counties April 21- at Steve Dulins.
