Lex. Park Vol. Fire Dept represented by J.B. Caldwell, Pres and T.R. McKee, treas called to present budget for this year (as suggested by the auditor) for Fire Tax and to what use it will be put. Commissioners have no responsibility for this tax, they turn it over to the Fire Dept. But list of receipts must be kept for auditor. The first payment is anticipated in Sept. as requested.

No decision. Will take this up at meeting with clergy this afternoon. If Dell's bus can bring them in to transfer to St John's bus, ok.

Letter from Arthur Briscoe thanking the Board for their cooperation in regard to having the Jean's Sportswear operate in the County, and to assist with the salary-- however, no money will be paid out by the Board until the factory operates.

SRC- Mr. Duncan and Mr. Bond came in about the letters from Waring & Son and the Commissioners regarding the drainage problem in Patuxent Park A lengthy discussion followed Mr. Duncan recommends pipes be laid 400 ft down R/W and empty into a ravine. Mr. Bond will have the Lex. Pk Vol Fire Dept pump out the lines; Mr. Waring will have a man from the Water Co there on the date selected to use snake to determine whether the pipes are filled with leaves and debris or otherwise. No further plans until this has been done.

Allan Brylaski, Treas Regulations read- Mr. Sterling will make reply for Board- Association has authority to grant the use of the park to outsiders Board requested that bills be handled in a specific way- all bills to be sent to the association for approval, then sent to Board for payment. Association was requested to submit a budget for operation of the park- prior to March, in order that it may be included in the 60-61 Budget for the County. After consideration of all matters letter will be written to the officers of the association with County's reply.

At four oclock Rev. Wilkinson, Holy Face; Rev. Downey, St. Aloys & Fr. Brown; Fr. Monohan, St Johns; Fr Behr, St Josephs. came in to discuss transportation of pupils to parochial schools. Jos Herbert to be advised that his route is to be reversed Banks child enrolled at St Johns will be transported by the parish.
