All officials were present at today's meeting.

Letter sent to Scanlon Herbert advising him to have Rear Stop lights repaired on PS bus  
" " " Chas. Jos. Herbert regarding mileage to and from St Jos white and St  
Jos colored school, and from traffic light on State Rd to Fr. Andrew White school  
and back to traffic light. This service was not to have been paid for by the County.

Letter to Fr. Wilkinson regarding above transportation.

Commissioners set \$2,000 in budget for Mosquito Control for 1960-61, and if no  
request made for Beetle Control an extra \$500 may be added. Dr. Foster had asked for  
at least \$4,000 for this work.

Dr. Houser came in to explain that where there are communicable diseases in the County  
they must be sent to Balto City Hospital, as the County has no facilities to care for  
these cases. If the family of the ill person can pay the bills, they are required to do  
so. If the family cannot pay the County is liable for them. This is a Pub. Health Law

Fatsy Ann Day has polio. so the Polio Foundation will take care of her expenses.

Due to the illness and absence of a County Health Officer in a neighboring County  
Dr. Houser is absent one day each week from Leonardtown to substitute for the ill  
County Health Officer.

Cards are being printed to be given to purchasers of Bldg Permits; cards will be  
heavy cardboard, weather proof for several months, stating that a Bldg Permit No...  
has been issued for this building, giving number of and date of issuance of permit.  
They are to be displayed on the building.

Delegation from Herring Creek area came in- Messrs Meatyard, Beard, Giddings, Colbin-  
Burdette and Adams of the Corps of US Army Engrs. was with them- to talk about  
opening Herring Creek. The Commissioners agreed to accept paragraphs a-b-c-d-e  
of the Army Engrs. letter of Nov 17- cost of project will be approximately \$4,500  
of which property will be requested to share. Messrs Meatyard and Hodges stated  
they would make a contribution. DEED for the land necessary must be made to the  
USGovt-this is a public landing.

Sen. Bailey with Mr. Krieger and Spencer of the Balto SRC came in to brief the  
Commissioners on the meeting set for tonight on proposed SRC 242, M,lestown to  
Clements.
