The meeting held this morning, with all present, began with Jr. Maley to discuss usual matters.

Mrs. Bittner was asked to come in and then asked if she thought the library could operate with 3¢ on the basis instead of the usual 4¢ on the basis, from the County. She felt this could be done but suggested that Admr. Johnson and members of the Library Bd be consulted. An appointment was made to meet with Admr. Johnson the following Tuesday.

Chap. Thompson came in, in the afternoon, to discuss the requests in the 1960-61 Budget for Civil Defense and Emergency Central Control. He agreed to a cut for Civil Defense and Emergency Central Control. In the latter they were to retain 1 Chief operator and 3 assistants, allow for annual and sick leave and substitutes, postage, supplies etc as now in the Budget.

W. Stanley Donaldson was called in to advise the Board about the extra work he is doing in the Treasurer's office. He informed them that the work requires someone with a good knowledge of accounting.

Lengthy discussion was held about the proposed Budget for 1960-61.

All present this morning when Mr. Stollman of Horse Head Road came to ask if the SRC would replace the fence on his property when they take over a section of his land- he was advised they would.

Mr. Grover Stone with Mrs. Bohle and Mrs. Wolfram came to inquire if their road which runs off SR235 between Mechanicsville and Oraville could be maintained by the County. They were advised that as soon as the Bd. made their annual inspection of roads this question could be answered

Mr. Robt. King, Bd. of Educa came in about the proposed Budget for 1960-61
Jr. Maley came in the afternoon about usual road matters. Letter written at request of Commissioners asking that position of Foreman for the 4th District be held open.

Admr. Johnson and group of Trustees for County Mem. Library came in response to Commissioners' request about the proposed cut from 4¢ to 3¢ for the library allotment. They appeared satisfied when the Commissioners spoke of a flat allotment of \$14,000 and asked that this be paid monthly instead of semi-annually. Bd. agreed.

PUBLIC HEARING on proposed budget for 1960-61 set for March 22, 1960 at 2:30 pm notice sent to 3 County papers. 3 County papers also asked to publish the Proclamation for "Save Your Vision Week" March 6th to 12th.
