Mr. Weisman was informed he would be advised just what could be done in this matter. Registered letter was sent to Mr and Mrs Biddle asking them to be in the Commissioners office on Tuesday April 12, at 10 a.m. Mr. Weisman is to be contacted and letter sent to all the people he recalls whose children have been attacked by this dog- asking them to attend the meeting. Dr. Houser-and Mr. Clemens Gaines of the State Dept of Health came to say good morning to the Board. They suggested that the base boards at the County Health Dept could be reglued.
