All officials present today.

Mrs. Gaulkie from Welfare Bd. came to discuss the hospital bill of Robert Mathias Clayton—he has an account of \$1,094.93. Welfare instructed the Commissioners to ask the bank for \$795.00 which leaves the amt of \$299.93 in bank. Letter to be sent to State Bd. of Health, Mental Hygiene, Dept of Collection asking them what amount of the \$795 is due them, and what is due the Commissioners. Mr. Wm. Clayton, brother of Robt. was also present and brought check for \$795.00 to the Commissioners.

Mr. King and Mr. Ucker, Bd. of Education came to ask for an additional sum from the State School Loan \$250,000.00 it has not been determined where this money will be used but it was necessary to ask that this sum be held for this County.

Shrf. presented a bill for ad in Beacon for sale of a boat, this was not included with the disbursement made and the Commissioners agreed to pay it.

Irvin Schubrook Rd needs pipe and gravelling from #5 almost to #235 St. Inigoes almost to Dameron

Mr. McCarl and representative of SRC Bridge section came to talk about Dillon Creek- SRC has applied to the Corps of Army Engineers for permission to erect a 30ft steel span with 6' clearance Cost of bridge not determined as yet

Pipe needed at entrance to Mirfield and Dent Drives in Town Creek Manor Mr. McCarl will see if Federal Flooding Program can assist in the matter of Great Mills flooded area. Letter sent to Rep. Lankford asking what, if anything, he can do to help in this matter, also asking for any literature he may have on the Fed. Fld. program. (WOES dictated letter)

Mr. McCarl will advise how much land is needed for the Chas. Wood entrance at St. Mary's City- State will condemn the land-County will pay for same St. Mary's City to Ridge- on this road Commissioner Bailey will suggest to the State SRC that less R/W is needed and advise the Commissioners

Mr. Lipski came with the Audit for 1959-60 and talked about County matters
