Should Mr. Lancaster be unwilling to give the R/W or sell at a nominal price, SRC will consider the possibility of condemning the land needed. Group from the SRC with the Commissioners will meet with Mr. Lancaster Sr and his son today at 3:15 pm on this matter.

Linwood Trossbach, Scotland, came about pipe for entrance to the County road below Dick Smith's home, and a drainage problem opposite the Trossbach home on the Cornfield Harbor road. Drainage problem will be looked into by Jr. Raley and he will contact Commissioner Hodges.

Mr. ^Ielton of the Harbor of Baltimore, USArmy Engineers, invited the Commissioners and their staff for a boat ride on Jan. 25th.
