He was advised the owner of the sub-division is responsible for building the road according to SRC specifications and road has not been checked for this. Mr. Raley will arrange a meeting with Robrecht and Commissioner John Hodges to check this road.

Mr. Robrecht asked if the Paro. school bus could possibly come in an additional 1/10 mi-18 small children live on this road and very dangerous for them to walk on the road. Commissioner Hodges will also look into this.

SRC- Bond and Raley also advised they would bring in chart showing work done up to 2-21-61.

Dr. Houser, Mr. Hartwell and Mrs. Peabody came to talk about the Nursing Home. Mrs. Peabody represented a large group of lay people as well as Gray Ladies who work at the hospital. Commissioners are definitely in favor of the project. They understand a Bill for same is being presented at this session of Md. Legislature.
