WHEREAS the Congress of the United States has approved and authorized as a Federal Project the improvement of a channel in ST. JEROME'S CREEK, St. Mary's County, Maryland, and other improvements in accordance with plans recommended in House Document No. 174-75th Congress, 1st session, subject to the provision by local interests of certain items of local co-operation. as set forth in said Document No. 174 AND

WHEREAS the County Commissioners of St. Mary's County, Maryland, are financially responsible to fulfill all required measures of local co-operation and desire to give formal assurance of the co-operation of St. Mary's County, in connection with said Project as required under said Document.  
BE IT RESOLVED, that the County Commissioners of St. Mary's County, Maryland hereby agree to the following requirements of local co-operation outlined in said Document.

### THIS COUNTY WILL

Hold and save the United States free from damages resulting from the construction and maintenance of the project, including such damages as may occur to oyster beds.
