All officials present today.

Messrs. Robert King and Harry Ocker of the Bd. of Education came in for the decision of the Commissioners on the proposed program for Pub schools to 1965. Commissioners discussed a \$2,000,000.00 bond issue to be brought before the people by referendum in 1962 Gen. Elec. for school construction. After discussing the possibility of an immediate Bond issue for \$1,000,000.00 they decided to wait for the referendum.

SRC. Mr. Bond and Jr. Raley came for the usual general road discussion. Mr. Moore of Spring Ridge Sub-division inquired as to steps to be taken before County was take over road for maintenance. Condition of road is to be checked by Comm. Hodges and Jr. Raley and they will report on this later.

M.C. Thompson, Jr., recently appointed District Engineer and State Roads Commissioner Paul Bailey appeared before the Board to discuss the County roads personnel in closed, exxcutive session. Mr. Thompson will

- 1 check present County roads personnel
- 2 ascertain if funds allocated to Construction- but not used- may be used for maintenance. This can be done in a future bond issue
- 3 Next Bond issue must be applied for in April and will be available in Aug.
- 4 Can Commissioners on SRC operate in the red for \$20,000.00 if this amount is picked up prior to July 1, 1961. Another matter discussed was that owners of sub-divisions should post sufficient bond for surface treatment of their roads.

Board adjourned at 4 pm
