Mr. and Mrs. Chas. Sandman, Scotland, presented a petition signed by 10 property owners of St. ohn's Manor sub-div. requesting County accept the road in this sub-div for maintenance. Approval of Commissioners was requested. They will study the situation and advise their decision. Mr. Latham left a letter and plat from McCrombe of Annapolis which he represents- relative to this project.
