All officials present.

SRC A petition signed by 70 property owners of the St. Jerome's Neck section, asking that the road be repaired and ditches cleaned out. Mrs. Trossback, Mrs. Vaughn, Mrs. Sirika and Mrs. Bradburn were present. Mrs. Trossback asked that the ditches be cleaned out immediately as water lies stagnant in her fields and she cannot plant her crops. Mr. Raley is familiar with the situation and will get to work there as soon as possible.

Messrs. Willingburg and Caldwell representing the Lex. Pk. Fire Dept property which is in the tract the Navy intends to dispose of shortly. They were advised the Commissioners had written to the Navy advising them of their desire to secure a tract of land including Community and Child Care bldgs., as well as the Fire Dept. However, they advised the Fire Dept to go ahead and try to purchase their property, if they could do so.

K.B. Duke, clerk to Supvsrs of Election presented a bill for \$150.00 for extra work on the Election Books. Bill was approved and paid.

Messrs. Jack Logan and Edwards, representing the Alys-Chalmers Equipment Co with Mr. Thompson and Mr. Raley discussed the need of equipment for the County SRC- Motor Grader- Crawler Tractor and Front End Loader.

Mr. Robt. King and Mr. Harry Ocker, Bd. of Educa. discussed the necessity of 20 additional class rooms needed by the Bd. of Educa, in the Lexington Park area; could use some of the houses Navy is no longer going to use - would not be included in the tract the County Commissioners desire to secure. Commissioners advised they have no objection to the Bd. of Educa. negotiating for these houses, but at this time the Commissioners would not intercede for the Bd. of Educa. in this matter.
