All officials except Atty. Sterling present.

Thos. L. Cryer of Medley's Neck area came to advise the Board he plans to establish a factory for manufacturing Liquid Plant Food, on his property. While the project needs no financial aid, Mr. Cryer would like a letter from the Commissioners, to be signed by Mr. Alvey, stating the Commissioners approve of the project, and understand no financial aid is required. Mr. Cryer will prepare the letter addressed to his firm, and Mr. Alvey will sign it.

Messrs. Robt. King, Harry Ocker, Robt. Blackistone, Ed. Young and Jas. Henderson, Bd. of Education, are interested in securing the Housing Units etc at Lex. Park which the Govt. is contemplating declaring surplus. Mr. Ocker feels the Bd of Education can secure all of the housing units, as well as the parcel of land with Community and Child Care Bldgs, and the tract on which is built the Lex. Park Fire House. Mr. Seddy of Health, Education and Welfare will meet with Mr. Ocker Wednesday. Commissioners have not been advised that they cannot obtain the areas they have requested. Bd. of Educa will ask Mr. Sedder in the event the Commissioners cannot secure the property they desire should the Bd. of Educa apply for all of it. Mr. Ocker will advise the Commissioners of Mr. Sedder's feeling in this matter. The Commissioners feels this would be a bad location for a school, too noisy and in the path of one of the main runways at the NATC Base. Bd. of Educa agreed it is not the most desirable place for a school but the land would be cheaper than any oother available now.

SRC- At the time Mr. Cullum and Jr. Raley came about County roads, Mr. Chas. Wood of St. Mary's City asked when he could expect an entrance to his property, which has been closed since the SRC built a new road there. Nothing has been done about this as yet.

Letter to be written MCThompson requesting a traffic count on the Maude Gardiner Road, 4th Dist., to establish whether this road is eligible for Federal aid.

List of 9 laborers to be employed by the SRC for County road work was approved by the Commissioners Employment begins July 5th.

Check for \$11,216.90 made to the SRC was drawn on the Treasurer's account for use in construction and reconstruction of County roads. Treasurer will be reimbursed when Bond issue is received.

Letter to be sent SRC to check the Boss Bailey road in the 7th, Oliver Guyther's subdivision. Letter to be signed by Mr. Alvey. ✓
