Present at today's meeting were County Commissioners C.B.Guy and J.M.Hodges and James M.Hodges, Jr., Administrative Asst.

At the office of Alex H. Brown & Son, Balto.Md. to sign the County Road Bonds purchased by Brown & Son were Treas. F.G.Cecil, Pres. Bd. L.S.Alvey, Clerk, Sara M.King and Atty Wm. O.E.Sterling who affixed the County Seal to each bond.

Mr. Caros, Welfare Bd. came in to explain he felt the County may be eligible for "Matching Funds" for the new building, from the Dept. of Health, Education and Welfare. He was asked to look into this matter and report.

Mr. Townsend of the 7th Dist came to complain about the 20% blanket raise on taxes and was advised that was a matter to take up with the Supervisor of Assessments

Sts. Atty. Jos. A. Mattingly with Dep. Shrf. George Sanger reported that Wm.Ray a prisoner in Huntsville, Texas, was wanted in St. Mary's County for forgery of checks. Ray will be released from jail in Texas on Nov 6th and the Comms were asked to assign Dep. Shr. Sanger with State Trooper Ely to proceed to Texas and bring back Ray for trial. Check for \$300.00 was advanced to Sanger for the trip with the agreement that if his expenses are less he will refund the excess, and if they are more he will be paid the balance. He will keep an itemized account of all expenses incurred on the trip.

Jr. Raley came in to discuss SRC matters in general. Commissioners had received a letter from Mr. Funk advising them that the SRC will hold a meeting in Baltimore with reference to the removal of snow from the County roads this winter. Jr. Raley will check with MC Thompson to see who will attend the meeting.

R. Moure, representing Tri-County Business Machines, LaPlata, demonstrated the IBM calculator; the Commissioners agreed to purchase on for the use of SRC if it doesnt exceed \$540 in price. Allowance on old machine brought new one to \$540 and it was ordered.

Mr. Burtt, Mosler Safe Co was given an order for 4 shelves for the safe in office of Supervisor of Assessments, \$8.60 each. No file cabinets were ordered at this time.
