Wm. E and Margaret Bowman explained they had been paying taxes on property not belonging to them. They requested refund and also bills for their own property. Matter was talked over with Mr. Cecil and Mr. Abell, and bill was approved for refund.

SRC Aubrey Cusic came in and advised the Board the SRC is busy cleaning up dump sites and filling as many pot holes in roads as they can, getting ready for winter weather.
