Our group has noted with pleasure your reported disapproval of the plan of Patuxent Water Company to dump the effluent from its proposed "lagoon" into Hilton Run and ultimately into the St. Mary's River. Our gratification is based on the threat to our oyster industry, our riparian rights and property values among other issues.

We look forward to your expression on this matter which is very close and passionate to us all.
