Comms. agreed they were ready to settle with Col. Peake on matter of tax sale property. He will be asked to attend meeting Mar 27- to settle this.

Bid from Womack Industries Inc. accepted for pest control in Court House, Jail & jailor's bungalow. adds \$20 per mo to his present contract. Bid was \$240.00 per yr. *\* 20 per mo to added to this reg. monthly check*

SRC Jr. Baley came to discuss general road matters. crews been at work on roads broken up by recent snow. Bill Cosden of Piney Pt. Shores complained of stagnant water in pools standing in yards of residents in this area. SRC will open ditch on one side of road, but not obliged to do so on opposite side, unless land for another entrance is DEEDED to them, after survey is made and deed recorded, at no cost to Comms.

Hearing on rezoning from "C" residential to Commercial, 8th Elec. Dist from proposed Fr. D. Roosevelt Blvd, crossing Midway & Essex Drives to present commercial district. There being no protests, Comms. agreed to request. Copy of Resolution hereto attached. Messrs Jack Daugherty and Allan Brvlawski were only attendants.

Comms. to provide for Relief Switchboard operator.

Comms. adjourned at 3 PM to meet Chas. Co. Comms. at Animal Shelter for final inspection.
