

March 27, 1962

Regular meeting held today, all officials present.

Mrs. Hayden with Messrs. Robt. E. King, Harry Ocker, Ed. C. Henderson and Leo Young, of the Board of Education came regarding the budget request for the Bd. of Educa for 1962-3. They hoped the increment allowed would be \$1477,500. but the Commissioners had only allowed \$125,000.00. No decision to change this amount was made at this time. A lengthy discussion was had on the subject.

Mrs. Maude Gardiner complained that water stays on her farm and does not run off, -near the run near the County road on her farm in Chaptico. She was advised the County road will be built in 1962, and this should correct matter.

Jr. Raley came in for the usual weekly SRC discussion. Amt. now in SRC account was considered. 61 program for roads is underway and one for 1962 will be presented soon.

Letter to be sent Mr. Luning, Cornfield Harbor, advising him the Commissioners had visited the site on his property and saw the problem but stated nothing can be done at this time in taking over the road. Letter to be sent to 2611 So. 8th St, Arlington, Va.

Mr. King brought up the matter of the Amish people who advised there is a very crowded condition in their schools. He advised them they could not expect any assistance from the County Commissioners.

Rosemary Abell, switchboard operator came to talk about a Relief operator for 1 hr, midday, every day and more time if and when she desired it. Mrs. Sally Guy agreed to come in for \$1.25 per hr for any length of time desired. Commissioners decided not to deduct all cost of relief operators during Rosemary's recent illness.

Commissioners passed a Resolution authorizing M. Chapman Thompson, Jr to act for them in securing Fall Out Shelter license or privilege from the USA for this County. Resolution is attached hereto.

Mr. Stephen Foxwell, inspector of work on the Tall Timbers seawall will furnish statement to the Commissioners when materials for the seawall being built by Jenkins Construction Co, Cole's Pt. Va is on the ground and work begun. Check will then be sent to Mr. Jenkins for the above.

Letter to USA Engrs, re Tall Timbers, Marina, F. Archie Meatyard signed by 3 Comms., copy attached hereto, carbon copy signed, sent to Mr. Meatyard.

Board of Education returned at 4 pm and were granted an increase to \$140,000.00 for increment for teachers.

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC
HEARING**

In accordance with Article 66B, Annotated Code, State of Maryland, Notice is hereby given that a Public Hearing will be held by the County Commissioners upon the application of property owners to zone to "A-residential" all those lands described as follows: Starting at the intersection of the southwest line of the property of Benedict Smith with the southwest side of the county road leading from the St. Peter Claver Church Road into the Smith subdivision, thence running with the property line between the said Benedict Smith and the Cardinal Gibbons Institute property in a straight line to the head of a cove, thence following the shore line of Smith Creek in a northerly and easterly direction to the head waters thereof, thence crossing along or near the entrance road from State Route 5 to the St. Peter Claver Church Road to a point approximately .202 miles from State Route 5, thence leaving the aforesaid entrance road to the Church and running with the northwesterly line of said Church property to the aforesaid County Road to the point of beginning; excepting therefrom the area designated as "Park" containing 1.2 acres and the lands owned by Robertson Barnes and James Lanham, all as shown on a map filed with the County Commissioners.

Such Public Hearing will be held on Tuesday Afternoon, April 3, 1962, in the Court House, Leonardtown, Maryland, at 2:30 o'clock, at which time arguments for and/or against the zoning will be heard.
