

July 10, 1962

Commissioners Alvey and Guy were present, for the morning session. Mr. Alvey was present until 2:30 Messrs. Hodges, Sterling and Duke were in Washington.

Minutes of the last meeting were read and a change was made in the Alms House property item-the Alms House is to be used for a Nursing Home, if approved by the State Health authorities-the cottages for aging couples was not being considered at this time.

Members for Local Welfare Bd.

Letter from Judge Waxter, Dir. State Dept of Welfare requested suggestions for 2 new members to replace Messrs John R. Drury, Sr and Wellington Hewett. Clerk was requested to contact Mrs. Veronica Hutchins, Tall Timbers and W. Clarke Mattingley, Leonardtown. This was done-both accepted. Letter was sent to Judge Waxter advising names and their acceptance.

Vouchers approved for salaries for Mos. Control work June 25-July 2 & paid.

Messrs Barnard Smith & Wiley Hartwell came about plumbing being installed in a house in Long View Beach for Mrs. Frances Washington- Bldg permit #2370. Randolph Construction Co of Arlington is contractor- plumbing not in accordance to State Code- photos presented showing violations. Mr. Oliver of the above firm- (phone Jackson 4-2010) agreed to remove all plumbing and do the job properly according to Mr. Hartwell's information. Mrs. Washington advised she cannot reside in the house until this is done properly.

Robt. Armstrong purchased Bldg Permit #2443 for 1 room addition to house in Avenue, addition to cost \$2,195.00. This permit is being used to erect a dwelling west of SRC 242 at SRC 234 1 mi north of Hurry Road. Permit is visible from road J. Louis Mattingly, Spec. Insp. was requested to check on this. Percolation test was not necessary to secure bldg permit to add to already completed bldg at Avenue, but Health Dept would not issue approved Perco Test on site of above new house.

Baptist Church Rd Mr. Wm Wood reported this road in very bad condition, makes a bottle neck- $\frac{1}{2}$ mi to new SRC5 Mr. Guy is trying to secure a R/W from Fox Lumber Co., from old #5 to new #5-if this is done road will be corrected before '63

Letter from Mrs. Mary R Julisson, re road at Cornfield Harbor- Mr. Guy requested clerk to write an explanatory letter to her-advising this is private road-funds for rebuilding and maintaining County rds are reduced from Gasoline Tax - not sufficient amount of this product sold here to bring the funds up to required level for all road work Commissioners would like to do.

\$2500.00 budgeted to all Vol Fire Depts except 8th Dist. Clerk to ask Mr. Thompson if Commissioners are to retain \$1,000.00 from each company to pay part of cost of Power units for emergency use -to be matched by Civ. Def.

Tax Sale for Delinquent Taxes on Tall Timbers Erosion Relief Property date of sale set for Friday Aug 31, 1962 at 2 pm at Court House door.

Vouchers for all Sanitary fills- Fire Depts and Rescue Squads to be ready for approval July 17- (except 8th D which has its special fire tax)

Mr. Alvey reported receiving a call from Dr. Greenwell regarding sending a person to an institution in Fla., as he considers the patient insane and needing treatment. Mr. Alvey did not approve this- patient spends several months here each year, then leaves-not a matter for this County.

Mrs. Clarke-Register of Wills reported that her telephone bill runs about \$10.80 per month, and once in a while a toll charge.
