When the Commissioners met today all officials were present. Minutes of the previous meeting were approved as read.

Nursing Home - this subject was discussed by the Commissioners and representatives of the Citizens group (who had previously come to ask that such a Home be erected-) Dr. A.D. Houser and W. Clarke Mattingley. It had been agreed that if and when a Nursing Home is erected it is to be located on the Alms House property. The Commissioners made the following suggestions

1. That they contact Mr. Fred Tilp, architect, and request that he draw up tentative plans for the proposed building;
2. to secure the services of a qualified Engineering firm and ask that the firm perform the necessary engineering for the building; also that this firm ascertain if the proposed lagoon disposal system can be tied in with this building and any others that may be erected later on this plot;
3. that the proposed Nursing Home be located on the Alms House property near the intersection of SRC 5 and 244- State Highway and Medley's Neck Road.

SRC Dennis Raley, Jr., came in to report on the progress of work on the County highways, which he feels is going along satisfactorily. Check in the amount of \$26,070.19 drawn from the local Bond Issue to the SRC, was given Mr. Raley for use in rebuilding and construction work on the County roads.

Court House air conditioning system- Commissioners decided the janitor is to run the air conditioning at night during the extremely hot weather, and to cut it off nights when the temperature is medium.
