Additional Space for Bd. of Education & State Police

Mr. James H. Ogden, Asst. Supt. of Bd. of Education, requested additional space in the County Office Bldg. Mr. Ogden was advised that the State Police have also requested additional space in that building, and no decision can be made until the State Police determine whether or not it will be feasible for them to move to other quarters.

Navy Recruiting Office

Recruiting Officer L.F. Newborn, USN, 3842 Penna Ave, SE, Wash DC came at the instance of the US Navy Dept to ascertain if there were space in the Court House for a Recruiting Office. He was advised there would be space for such an office when needed.

Paro. Trans. Extension

Mrs. Leoma Hebb was granted an extension of $2\frac{1}{2}$ miles per ^{school} day to her Paro. School route- beginning Sept. 1962. Extension would be 50¢ per day, \$7.50 per mo, \$90.00 per yr. The amt. of \$7.50 is due for Sept-Oct- \$15.00, therefore \$22.50 should be added to her Nov check making a total of \$692.50 and thereafter her check will be \$677.50 each month.

Alms House Pump

Smith's Inc., Leonardtown, were authorized to install a water pump in the County Alms House, to cost approximately \$105.00 complete.

Sypher Lane. 8th Elec. Dist.

Mr. and Mrs. Ed Sypher, came to request that Sypher Lane, 8th Elec. Dist be accepted by the County Commissioners for maintenance. This has been done and the County Roads Commission was advised by letter that Plats, R/W etc., are ready and DEED is recorded in CBG Liber 104 folio 308. , road is to be included in County Roads system for maintenance, only.

County Roads work was reported by Jr. Raley as progressing satisfactorily.
