Sheriff's Department

General discussion concerning amendments to sheriff's bill as requested by Sheriff Burroughs, regarding appointment of additional deputies. It was decided that the sheriff would be advised that his department should operate under the present bill for the time being, and if at the end of the year it was felt changes were needed, they would be considered at that time. Copies of the letter will be sent to Senator Paul Bailey, and Delegates Fowler and Briscoe.

Junked Cars

The commissioners discussed matter of removing junked cars from the county and how best to handle this problem. The law was reviewed and it will be amended to make the property owner responsible for removing cars abnadoned on his property.

Civil Defense Radios

The commissioners approved request for purchase of five radios, as approved by Gen. Hogaboom. The cost of the radios is \$739.00 each, with an additional \$87.00 for the two-channel requested for Fire Company #3. Total cost will be \$3,782.00, and this amount will not exceed the amount budgeted for equipment for this fiscal year.
