Present: All commissioners.

Impounded Property

It was reported that Sheriff Burroughs has asked about disposition of the property being held by former Sheriff Meidzinski, which the latter refuses to relinquish. Sheriff Burroughs said he is going to speak with Judge Dorsey and Judge Digges about this and is going to do something about it. These items belong to the county, and in some instances to individuals, who want to recover them. Mr. Burch said it would be his feeling that the sheriff should do whatever is necessary in order to recover these things, and the commissioners agreed.

Transceiver in Lexington Park

Mr. Aud said that Judge Dodge has request this equipment in the sheriff's office in Lexington Park, and that the state police are in agreement. The commissioners approved this provided the state police are in agreement, and send a letter to the commissioners to this effect.

Animal Shelter Reconciliation

The commissioners approved payment of St. Mary's County share of the semi-annual reconciliation in the amount of \$1,045.11, for expenses of the animal shelter.

Tax Abatement

Section 191, St. Mary's Code of Local Laws, will be called to Mr. Donaldson's attention regarding publication of tax abatements for corporations.

Lexington Park Library

Mr. Burch and Mr. Aud approved payment of Requisition #2, in the amount of \$19,170.00, for the library being constructed in Lexington Park, as approved by Mr. Stanley Arthur, architect. This is to be paid to M. Dean, Inc.

Erosion Control Projects

Mr. Aud and Mr. Burch approved applications to the state for funds for construction. Mr. Burch signed applications for various projects, as follows: Camp Merryelände, St. George Island, requesting \$2,000 from the state, total cost \$4,000; Bushwood boatramp, requesting \$5,000; Tall Timbers boatramp, requesting \$3,000. The sisters at Camp Merryelände, have agreed to pay \$2,000 of the cost of the project there. Mr. Bowles returned to the meeting and approved the above action.

Forest Warden


