3rd District Sanitary Fill

Letters and petitions against this proposed facility were reviewed, and request for a meeting with the Commissioners to discuss it. The Commissioners agreed that a letter should be sent to the Bensons and Rickells advising them that such a meeting at the present time would serve no purpose, as the Health Department study for this area has not been completed.

The Pub Property

The Commissioners agreed to table for the present the matter of the deed from Zanzinger and Sasscer for the right of way for Roosevelt Boulevard, which runs from Shangri La Drive to the southern boundary of the Pub property, in the 8th District, as said right of way provides area for a deadend street.

Mental Health Advisory Committee


