State and County Taxes

Mr. Donaldson requested the Commissioners to make a resolution stating that the State and County taxes 1956 and prior are uncollectable and should be abated as in Article 81, Section 67 and Section 212, in the amount of \$2,044.59. Minutes of October 29, 1968

The minutes of the October 29, 1968 meeting were reviewed. Mr. Burch moved that these minutes be accepted. Mr. Aud seconded the motion. Mr. Bowles abstained from voting.

Dave Bailey Road

Mr. Bowles suggested that Mr. Douglas Bond, of the State Roads Commission, do some temporary work or maintenance on the Dave Bailey Road as there is a cedar tree obstructing the view. He also requested that this road be put on the schedule for surface treatment next year. Mr. Bond will be instructed to take care of this matter.

Gosnell Road

Mr. Bowles requested that Mr. Pantaleo contact Mrs. O'Donnell regarding the renaming of Gosnell Road in the Second Election District and to report to the Commissioners at their next meeting.

McLeod Dump

The Commissioners met with Mr. McLeod for an on-site inspection of the McLeod dump. It had been reported that someone had been burning directly under the electric lines. It was suggested to come back 50 feet from the line and dig a trench to avoid trash being dumped or burned under the power lines. The Commissioners decided to meet with Mr. McCleod to correct the situation.

Mr. Burch approved vouchers #33971 to #34195.
