He stated that he had invited Mr. Chuck Claypool to draw the specifications for a $1\ 3/4\ yd$. bucket and also $1\frac{1}{2}\ yd$. bucket. Mr. Claypool will meet with the Commissioners next week.

Mr. Raley stated that he would accept a salary of \$11,128 which would go to \$12,400.00 in six years. Mr. Pantaleo presented plans for a proposed building the Commissioners may wish to consider. Discussion was had regarding various designs which also included the Mosquite Control building.

Sheriff's Dept.

Mrs. Maryln Weiland could not accept position so the County Commissioners approved the hiring of Miss Carol Poe of St. George Island for part-time help from 11:30 - 4:30 p.m. at \$2.50 per hour.
