Oakville Sanitary Landfill

Mr. David Williams and Mr. Bob Moore reviewed the plat of the dump site property near Oakville. Discussion was had concerning the location of a road leading off of Route 235.

Kingston Creek

Mr. Pantaleo presented a letter from Mr. Burch's signature to Mr. Louis Phipps of the Department of Chesapeake Bay Affairs, regarding the dredging and jetties on Little Kingston Creek and Kingston Creek. A letter was received stating a quotation on this work of \$26,442.20, submitted by Mr. Edwin A. and Mr. John O. Crandall, of West River, Maryland. The Commissioners requested that the Department of Chesapeake Bay Affairs construct this project as a State funded project. They requested that the previously allocated funds of \$5,000 for this project be withdrawn in lieu of the request hereby being made.

Abell Clarke Trailer Park

The Commissioners unanimously approved Mr. Abell Clarke's Trailer Park on the Wise-St. Andrews Church Road.

Historical Society Building


