#### Safety Control Program

Corporal M. Sandidge informed the Commissioners of the safety program that is to be put into effect that will cover safety measures for boating, driving, water safety, fire safety, etc. There will be films shown at no cost, and also booklets available at a nominal cost. He presented listing of expenses that will be incurred, totaling \$985, stating that the Maryland Safety Commission will appropriate \$500 if the county will match it. Corporal Sandidge said he would like to know this money is available even if all of it is not spent. This money would carry them through June 30, 1969. Next year they are going to try to get the entire \$1,000 from the state so that the county will not have to contribute anything.

Mr. Burch advised the corporal that this will be discussed with our attorney to determine if the Commissioners can legally grant funds in this respect, and the corporal will be so informed.

#### Auditor's Fees

The Commissioners approved payment of \$2250 to David M. Gruber, for services for 3rd quarter, Fiscal Year.

#### Public Hearing on Golden Beach Road

Hearing advertised as required by law notifying public of intent to alter present alignment of Golden Beach Road. There were no persons present to either protest or speak in favor of the project.

#### Airport

Mr. Burch and Mr. Aud approved payment of \$2,000 for engineering services on this facility, to Rader & Associates for the month of February 1969.

#### Civil Defense

The Commissioners approved payment of \$1880.31 to Loffler Construction Company, as approved by Mr. F. Tilp, Architect, for construction of the stairway shelter. Approved Change Order #1, and it was signed by Mr. Burch. Approved payment of \$299.92 to Mr. Tilp for architect fees.

#### Beavin Company

The Commissioners approved payment of \$5400 to this firm for February engineering and other services on the Master Water and Sewage Plan, which is now 65% completed.

Piney Point Committee

The Commissioners approved payment of \$40.93 to Mrs. Kitty Barnes for telephone calls made in connection with the work done by this Committee. Proof of all calls made submitted with statement.

Norris Fence

The Commissioners approved payment of \$39 and \$19 for fence materials purchased from the So. Md. Wood Treating Corp., for installation on Mr. B. Norris property on St. Andrews Church Road. The fence had to be replaced as the original one was removed due to the reconstruction of this road.

State Mental Institutions


