The minutes of the previous meeting, held on Tuesday, June 22, 1970 were not read.

Mr. Ollis P. Wood, Acting Director, Office of Civil Defense

Mr. Ollis P. Wood appeared to request raises in pay from \$20 per hour to \$21.50 per hour for emergency and part-time radio dispatchers employed at the County Emergency Control Center. Mr. Wood stated that the 200 was equal from 50 to 75 hours of part-time help each week; indicated the need by presentation of time sheets for increased assignments during the peak hours of the week as well as the week-end; and indicated that the hours of "stand-by" had diminished to a minimum of four hours within the two-to-four hour period -- i.e., from 10:00 to 12:00 a.m. The Board on County Commissioners approved a pay increase from \$1.50 per hour to \$21.50 per hour for part-time and emergency help. Approval was also granted for the transfer of employees from the 1970-71 budget into the 1971-72 budget. Such funds will be used for the purchase of emergency food for reserves by National Civil Defense Technicians and the relative supplies for the reserves.
