LEONARDTOWN, MD – The Commissioners of St. Mary's County (CSMC) began their business meeting with an invocation and the pledge, followed by approval of the consent agenda.

The CSMC then presented proclamations in recognition <u>National Family Caregiver Month</u> and <u>Animal Shelter Appreciation Week</u>.

The Commissioners then received a <u>presentation</u> from John Hartline, Executive Director of the Tri-County Council.

During County Administrator Time, the Commissioners took the following action:
